Protecting Yourself From Fraud

For People With Medicare:

- The Marketplace won't have any effect on your Medicare coverage.
- It's against the law for someone who knows you have Medicare to sell you a Marketplace plan.
- Do not share your Medicare number or other personal information with anyone who contacts you uninvited to sell you a health plan.
- If you believe your Medicare number has been compromised, contact 1-800-Medicare immediately.

For People Without Medicare:

- Beware of scammers! Don't give your personal information to anyone.
 - Keep a record of a salesperson's name or anyone who may assist you, who they work for, telephone number, street address, mailing address, email address and website.
 - Don't sign anything you don't understand. Ask questions if any information is unclear.
